Leadership Training Conducted by Mrs. Amanda Hagy

- Discussed importance of leadership and how its required to ensure that service projects can completed timely
- Discussed qualities and characteristics of a good leader including kindness, compassion, respect, and more
- Discussed the 6 types of leaders:
 - Visionary This type of leader notifies the team of the end goal, but doesn't dictate the ways or methods used to achieve this goal
 - Coaching This leader connects the personal values and ideals of team members with the organization's goals
 - Affiliative This leader places emphasis on emotional connections between team members which can reduce conflict and encourage inclusion
 - Democratic This leader relies on active input and collaboration from team members
 - Pacesetting This leader expects excellence from team members and will complete the tasks themselves to ensure that targets and goals are met
 - Commanding This leader uses autocratic methods which can include orders, threats, tight control
- Case study where Mrs. Hagy described 2 accounts of teams working together and asked attendees to identify the leaders in each of the scenarios to solidify their understanding of the different components of a leader

Diabetic Alert Dog Project (November meeting and 1st Half of Year)

Rising senior Skylar needs 25,000 dollars for a service dog who notifies owners of high/low blood glucose levels

- Diabetic alert dogs can notify diabetics of unusual blood sugar levels 20 minutes before a monitor can which will save the user from a life or death situation
- 8,000 to 9,000 dollars have already been raised; however, 16,000 to 17,000 still needed
- Lion Whitney Livingston proposed idea of each Leo Club having a challenge to raise 500 dollars for Skylar
- Can also be funded through grants from the Texas Lions Foundation

Child Trafficking Project (May meeting and 2nd Half of the Year)

- From ourrescue.org, run by Tim Ballard, an agent that reduced child trafficking victims
 - Before he would solely arrest the traffickers, but now he is dedicated to reducing the child victims
 - Children from border patrol are being sent to non-existent addresses
 - Ideas to encourage local leo clubs to aid their local shelters
 - Locations of shelters: Acuna (MX), Missouri, and Arizona
- Proposition to give percentage to the website
- Proposition to implement donation boxes in schools where hygiene products, food, blankets, clothes, and more can be donated to the shelters
 - Can address HUNGER part of LCI's main goals
- Money can be donated directly which can allow for those shelters to receive greater amounts of food, clothing, etc.
