Introduction of Paramedic Mrs. Montgomery by Treasurer Blain Montgomery

Stop the Bleed Presentation by Mrs. Montgomery

- Briefly discussed the different types of bleeding
 - Arterial bleeding is much more fatal than venous bleeding
- Main solution to stop bleeding is to use pressure
 - Items such as a towel, gauze, and shirt can be used to supply pressure
 - Never remove gauze! only add more
- Tool to help provide pressure is a tourniquet
 - Blue tourniquets are trainer tourniquets; real tourniquets are orange and black
 - Tourniquet \rightarrow blue is trainer tourniquet. Real comes in orange and black
 - Never put a tourniquet on a joint; only place them on extremities on the arms and legs
 - Instructions on how to use a tourniquet
 - Place the tourniquet two inches above the site of the word
 - Turn the handle until the bleeding stops. No more because it will inflict pain on the person
 - Ensure the tourniquet is secure, and write down what time the tourniquet was put on
 - Even if the bleeding stopped, don't remove the tourniquet
- Makeshift tourniquet
 - Triangle bandages, gauze, and some type of straight object like a pen or a ruler can be used to make a tourniquet
 - Wing can be used to make it more secure
 - Use what you have during an emergency, like a shirt, belt, shoelaces, etc.
- Packing wounds
 - Used when a sharp object such as scissors impale the skin
 - Do not remove the object or pull it out; instead, pack around it to make sure that it is stable
 - Use both fingers to go quickly in all directions of the wound
 - Pack a little bit at a time. If not, the gauze won't cover the entire wound
- Leos and Lions were able to practice tying tourniquets and packing wounds

Diabetic Alert Dog Update by Lion Nancy

- Skylar got his diabetic alert dog, but the dog hasn't been released yet as it requires more training
- Other organizations train other types of dogs, such as comfort dogs at college station
- Any money that was donated after Skylar met the total is donated to 11-year-old Elijah Davis, who was diagnosed last year

- Dogs can alert minutes before the glucose levels are too high or too low due to their heightened sense of smell
